





THE FACE OF A GIANT

CRUISING THE HUBBARD GLACIER

Among the many words used to describe Hubbard Glacier, 'humbling' is perhaps the most appropriate for North America's largest tidewater glacier. It is 122 km long and more than 9 km wide where it meets the ocean. It is approximately 183 metres tall at its terminal face -106 metres exposed above the waterline and 76 metres below. It is also over 609 metres thick at some locations. and the terminal face's ice originally fell as snow up to 500 years ago. From your blissful vantage point in Disenchantment Bay, prepare to be thrilled by the crack of this Alaskan colossus calving into a suddenly roiled sea.



TLINGIT HERITAGE

ICY STRAIT POINT (HOONAH), ALASKA

Immerse yourself in truly unspoiled wilderness. Set deep in the heart of the 17-million-acre Tongass National Forest the largest in the U.S. — this port is centred around a restored salmon cannery that features a museum, restaurants and local arts and crafts shops. Take a whale-watching tour from Hoonah, the largest Tlingit village in Alaska. Drive a Jeep along the old logging roads that criss-cross Chichagof Island, home to more brown bears than humans. Watch for Sitka black tailed deer and bald eagles as you ascend Hoonah Mountain in a window-walled gondola before riding a tram past towering stands of Sitka spruce and western hemlock.



SALMON, AXES & TOTEMS

KETCHIKAN, ALASKA

You need not know this Inside Passage town's history to be charmed by Creek Street's brightly coloured buildings perched on stilts over Ketchikan Creek. Of course, the more you learn, the more you'll appreciate the frontier mystique of this former 'Salmon Capital of the World'. Step aboard a pontoon boat for a cruise along the breathtaking George Inlet, passing the cannery — declared a historical landmark in 1996. Watch Alaska's lumberjacks battle British Columbia's premier woodsmen in a spirited competition. The indigenous Haida and Tlingit have made totem poles the emblem of Ketchikan — wander through Totem Bight State Historical Park to marvel at over a dozen.

GLACIER WATERS & LOCAL BREWS

JUNEAU, ALASKA

Surrounded by soaring mountains, wooded valleys, bay waters and the massive Mendenhall Glacier that calves into a lake 19 km away, Juneau's appeal somehow extends beyond its sublime location within Alaska's Inside Passage. The only U.S. capital city not accessible by road oozes gold-rush-era charm along narrow streets fronted by 19th-century architecture. A bevy of included excursions invites you to find your inner Alaskan watching for humpback whales, orcas and harbour seals, hiking with a naturalist and rafting a pristine river fed by waters from Mendenhall Lake. Back in Juneau, toast your trip to the Last Frontier at the Alaskan Brewing Company with a taste of locally made ales and lagers.



A GOLDEN EXPERIENCE

SKAGWAY, ALASKA

Beginning in 1897, this frontier town at the northernmost point of the Inside Passage was the starting place for more than 40,000 gold-rush stampeders who headed to the Yukon primarily by way of the Chilkoot Trail. EAGLE PRESERVE FLOAT ADVENTURE AND CRUISF SKAGWAY, ALASKA
